Veronika Dornburg was born on the 21th of December 1971 in Wülfrath, West Germany. From 1991 to 1999 she studied environmental technology at the Technical University of Berlin, specialising in waste management. During this time she worked as teaching assistant and was student representative in the educational committee of her faculty. In 1998 she did a 4-month traineeship in development cooperation at the GTZ (Deutsche Gesellschaft für Technologische Zusammenarbeit), working on solid waste management issues in Aqaba, Jordan.

Afterwards, she carried out her graduation research at the Department of Science, Technology and Society (STS), currently part of the Copernicus Institute of Utrecht University. She graduated in August 1999 on the subject of 'System analysis of biomass energy systems in relation to scale'. In December 1999 she became junior researcher at STS, developing a waste management optimisation tool for the Netherlands. Since September 2000 she has been working at STS as PhD-student on the subject of multi-functional biomass systems. During that time she was PhD student representative at the board of the Copernicus Institute.
